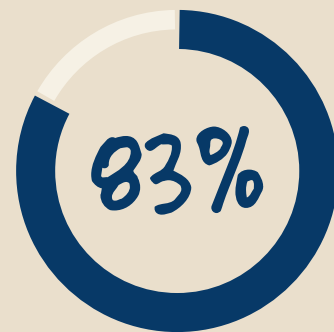

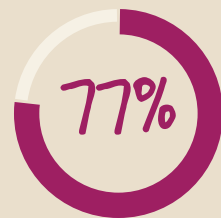

PERCENTAGE OF "GOOD" AND "EXCELLENT" RATINGS FOR WORKSHOP PERFORMANCE



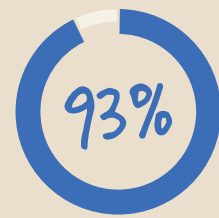

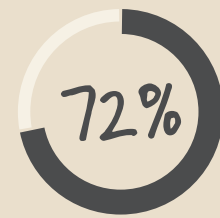

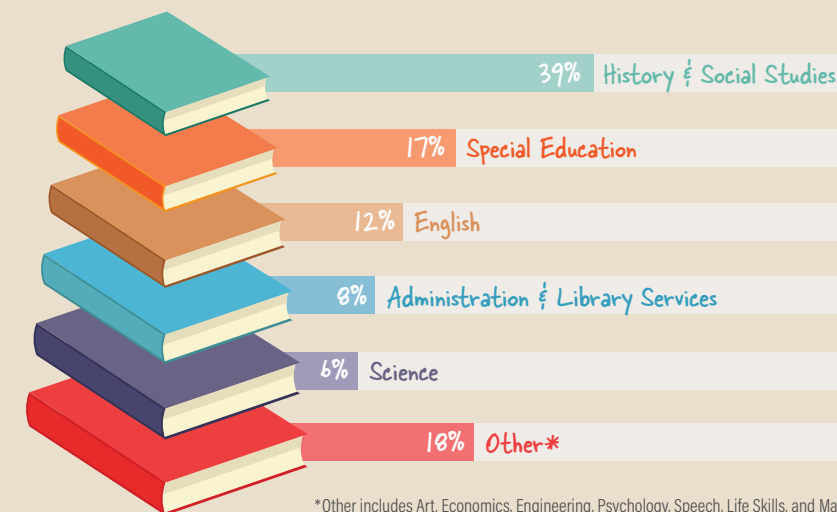

SUMMARY

The increases in self-reported ratings suggest the PD was an effective tool to promote:

- Teacher knowledge on disability rights and the disability movement
- Teacher knowledge about Universal Design for Learning
- Teacher confidence about meeting the learning needs of their diverse students
